**WESTON ROAD RECONSTRUCTION**  
**CONTRACT NO. 09C-410-1355**

Dear Weston Road Neighborhood Resident,

The Town of Wellesley will be paving Weston Road on Thursday, October 29, 2009, weather permitting. It will be necessary to close a portion of Weston Road beginning at 7:00 a.m. until completion of work. The paving work will take place at two locations; from MacArthur Road to Turner Road and at the Linden Street/Weston Road intersection to Curve Street. The closure plan for Weston Road has been developed with and approved by the Police Department. It is similar to the plan used when paving took place in August. Local traffic will be allowed to use Weston Road between Route 9 and MacArthur Road, including access to the Hardy School. Police officers will be positioned at various locations to help traffic flow. Residents within the area to be paved will be allowed access for their personal vehicles. No traffic will be allowed to use Weston Road during paving. Residents of streets that outlet to Weston Road should use other routes during the paving. There may be brief delays during the course of paving, but every effort will be made to let you access your property. It is requested that no truck deliveries or landscape maintenance activities be scheduled on that day.

Access will be provided to the Hardy School for student drop-off and pickup. The Weston Road/Linden Street intersection will be opened as soon as possible after completion of the paving. It is our intent to complete this work in one day to minimize the duration of inconvenience. As always, unforeseen circumstances such as weather may require a change in plans. If the work must be delayed, then notice will be posted on the electronic message boards at and around the project site, and the Town's web site.

This will complete the majority of the work for this season on the Weston Road project. However, some utility work will take place between Turner Road and Linden Street before the end of the current construction season. The project will resume to completion in the spring of 2010.

We would like thank everyone for their patience during the ongoing reconstruction of Weston Road.
